Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Greetings to you in the precious name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

We are grateful to share an update from the orphanage in Pakistan, along with some important prayer needs during this challenging time. By God's grace, the children have successfully completed their school examinations. They have worked very hard to finish their books, and we thank the Lord for granting them strength and understanding. The children are now on their spring break, enjoying a time of rest and enjoyment.

As we look ahead to the upcoming academic term, we are preparing to meet their educational needs. We will need new books and school supplies for the next semester so the children can continue their studies without interruption. We humbly ask for your prayers and support in this area.

At the same time, the overall situation in Pakistan—and across parts of the Middle East—has become increasingly difficult. Everyone knows of the situation with Iran, but Pakistan is in another war with Afghanistan. On top of this, they are having heavy rains and flooding in Afghanistan and Pakistan. Dozens of people have lost their lives over the last week. Pakistan is currently facing an extreme energy shortage, and the cost of living has risen sharply. Basic necessities have become more expensive,

placing a heavy burden on families and ministries alike. Due to these shortages and the unstable conditions, schools across the country have sent children home, disrupting their education and daily routines.

We also ask for your earnest prayers regarding growing challenges faced by the Christian community. This week the supreme court passed a law in Pakistan making it legal for Muslim men to marry underage Christian girls. The government still protects Muslim girls who cannot marry before 18. This new law removes protection for Christian girls who are kidnapped and forced into marriages with Muslim men. The government does not want to intervene in such cases. There are increasing reports of injustice, particularly toward vulnerable Christian girls, where protection and intervention are lacking. Please pray for the Christian minority in Pakistan who daily face discrimination and persecution.

In addition, a nationwide lock down has been announced over the Easter weekend. This is especially difficult, as Easter is the most significant and joyful celebration for Christians in Pakistan—a time when families gather to rejoice in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. These restrictions have limited their ability to come together in worship and celebration. In the midst of all these trials, we ask you to please pray that believers in Pakistan would remain strong, steadfast, and true to their faith. Pray that they would be encouraged, protected, and upheld by God's grace, and that His peace would sustain them through every hardship.

We are also thankful to share an answer to prayer. Little Areeba, who was burned this past winter, is doing much better. We praise God for His healing hand upon her life and thank you sincerely for your faithful prayers on her behalf.

Thank you for standing with us in prayer and support. Your partnership is a great blessing and encouragement to this ministry and to the children we serve.
